Petrozavodsk, Republic of Karelia, Russia October 18-19, 2018

The aim of the conference is to involve a wide range of experts from Russia and abroad in discussing the issues of regional and local socio-economic development, modern economic geography and spatial planning, improvement and promotion of regional and municipal statistics.

Background. The conference has been held since 1995 every second year, honouring the memory of a prominent Russian economic geographer, statistician, and enthusiastic educationalist K. Arseniev (1789-1865). His versatile scientific activities and historical connection to the City of Petrozavodsk and Karelia became a motivation for establishing a conference in memory of his scientific and public work and in recognition of his contribution to Russian and world science.

Conference participants. Scientists, specialists, professors and lecturers, legislators and administrators, NGOs, PhD students are invited to take part in the conference.

Main conference themes:

- Economic geography issues related to administrative arrangement and its enhancement, economic zoning, spatial planning, and spatial arrangement of production facilities considering modern processes of globalization, economic integration, regionalization and structural transformation of economy and economic space.
- 2. Spatial development statistics issues related to the improvement of the information and analytical support system for the development and adoption of management decisions in the area of spatial planning, statistical accounting, combining international and national statistical standards, the problems of the development of regional statistics and the formation of municipal statistics.
- 3. Use and development of modern statistical methods of measurement, analysis and modeling in studies of complex socio-economic processes.
- 4. New forms and methods of the digital economy that are formed in the management system, including all stakeholders in the development of the digital economy, as well as the elaboration of recommendations of international organizations and foreign experience and monitoring tools, including modernized and new forms of federal statistical monitoring of the digital infrastructure development.

It is planned to publish a collection of conference materials with the assignment of ISBN, UDC, BBK. The proceedings will be included in the base of the Russian Scientific Citation Index (**RSCI**) and SCIENCE INDEX, posted in the **eLibrary** scientific electronic library.

For placement in the RSCI, it is required to fill in the AGREEMENT and ACT (forms attached) in 2 copies and send by mail (scan to e-mail) to the Institute of Economics: Petrozavodsk, pr. A. Nevsky, 50, 185030.

To be admitted to the conference submit the application form as described below to the Institute of Economics of the KarRC of RAS before <u>September 1, 2018</u>, and send full paper <u>before October 1, 2018</u>.

The file name must match the first author's name and have the standard extension: **Ivanov.docx.**
