# 5<sup>th</sup> Jubilee Youth Economic Forum "INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC INTEGRATION"

# Petrozavodsk November 14-15, 2013

**THE PRINCIPAL OBJECTIVE** of the Youth Economic Forum is to combine the efforts of young scientists involved in economic researches by setting up a platform for discussion the theoretical and applied problems of socioeconomic development. This year we expect more than 200 participants from Russia and other countries.

**BACKGROUND:** the Youth Economic Forum has been organized in Petrozavodsk since 2008 with support from the Russian Foundation for Basic Research. The Forum is hosted by scientific and educational institutions, namely the KarRC of RAS Institute of Economics, Karelian Research Centre of RAS, Karelian Branch of the Russian Presidential Academy of National Economy and Public Administration, Petrozavodsk State University. Articles of the participating young scientists are published in the Forum's Proceedings.

**PARTICIPANTS:** University students, doctoral and postdoctoral students, young scientists, as well as their research supervisors are invited to participate. A special session with a wide range of economic topics will be organized for schoolchildren. There are no age limitations: any individuals or organizations with interests of relevance for the Forum profile and the youth scientific policy are welcome.

**THEMES:** The 5<sup>th</sup> Youth Economic Forum is devoted to international economic integration and its manifestations at different levels: from the global to the local. The Forum participants are encouraged to discuss the problems of economic interactions between countries and regions related to establishment of the international labour division system, relaxation of barriers and promotion of resource mobility, formation of integration networks and establishments, as well as the political, legal and social aspects of the problem.

The following thematic areas are suggested for sessions and roundtables:

- Economic integration as an aspect of globalization of the world economy;
- The formation of regional integration structures;
- Eurasian economic integration;
- Euroregion as a form of international integration;
- Russia and the WTO: the first results of the integration process;
- Russian business in the international division of labor;
- Inter-regional integration and national economic space of Russia;
- Cross-border cooperation of the regions and municipalities;
- International integration and innovative development;
- Social and legal aspects of economic integration;
- Migration in the development of the integration process;
- Integration for sustainable development and the transition to a "green economy".

We encourage you to make your own suggestions on a thematic session or roundtable in addition to the above, given that they fit in the Forum's "International Economic Integration" mainstream.

The deadline for submission of applications and full text papers has been shifted to *October 15<sup>th</sup>*, *2013*. Please e-mail them at forum insteco@inbox.ru

Before this date the participants can also send their proposals on the Forum program (topics for sessions, roundtables, master classes, etc.).

Only articles presented at one of the Forum sessions and approved by the editorial council will be published in the proceedings. Students and doctoral students are required to additionally submit a review of the article by a person with the doctoral or postdoctoral degree.

Personal participation is acceptable only.

The Editorial board is being formed. Experts interested in being taken onboard are invited. Applications will be accepted before **October 15**<sup>th</sup>, **2013**.

We'd be glad to offer you help with accommodation, as well as arrangements for the cultural programme, including excursions around the city, visits to museums, theatres, etc. Feel free to ask any questions you may have concerning participation in the Youth Economic Forum.
