
Defining the Green Belt of Fennoscandia in terms of society and development

- Goal: to find a unit which is understandable, important and useful in terms of development (society and nature use including protection)




Green Belt of Fennoscandia defined by regions

Border has been the decisive factor




Border checkpoints (international)





