The Conference will take place at the Karelian Research Centre RAS (11 Pushkinskaya St., Petrozavodsk, Republic of Karelia) on September 18-20, 2024.

The call for papers is now closed. Draft conference program is attached to this Circular. The Program may be subject to modifications until 18th September.

The abstracts submitted have been accepted and will be published electronically after the conference. Those who have not done so earlier are requested to submit the expert reports for abstract publication in the Conference Proceedings by September 20.

The tours will be accompanied by researchers from the Karelian Research Centre RAS and will be free of charge for the conference participants.
